- Submit Letter of Intent to high school
 - April 1st Deadline for 2021-2022 participation
 - COVID flexibility deadline extended to May 1st
- Complete Edison State's CCP admission process at www.edisonohio.edu/ccp
- Recommended completion (application & assessment)
 - May 1 summer & fall registration
 - November 1 spring registration

Qualification Process - Assessment

In order to participate in the CCP program, students must meet specific program and course eligibility criteria.

Program Eligibility

- Statewide standards for participation
- College-level assessment scores ACT, SAT, Accuplacer, etc.
- COVID Flexibility 3.0 cumulative HS GPA

- Multiple Measures

Selecting Courses

- Students are encouraged to select courses based on...
 - Career Pathway/Long-term goals
 - HS graduation requirements
 - Skill development or interest
- Students may take classes in any available format
 - High School if available
 - Edison State campus
 - Online must demonstrate online readiness
- View courses options online through MyESCC
- Prerequisite course work must be met
 - Example: ENG 121 before ENG 122
 - Assessment score prerequisites

Course Registration

- Registration occurs each semester
 - Summer, Fall, Spring

Courses offered on campus or online

- CCP Registration Form
 - All changes require GC authorization
 - Add, Delete, Drop, Withdraw
 - Must be submitted to Edison State prior to each term
 - Registration timeline, waitlists, HS registration dates

 - Must be completed prior to start of online coursework
