HOUSTON HIGH SCHOOL COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS 2021-2022

WHAT IS COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS?

- Courses taken for both high school and college credit
- A 3 credit hour or more college course = 1 high school credit
- May take courses here at HHS, on Edison's campus, or through Edison online
- Students must meet with Mrs. Merickel, then complete a set of requirements to qualify for CCP



PARTNERSHIP WITH EDISON STATE

- We continue our partnership with Edison State. For many years our students have taken courses through Edison, both on the college campus, and at Houston High School.
- One college means one set of requirements to meet for all CCP courses, both at Houston and at Edison



CCP ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Attend mandatory CCP meeting with Mrs. Merickel
- Request CCP courses on your Course Request Sheet
- Apply to Edison
- Email or ask Mrs. Merickel in person to send your transcript (report card for current 8th graders) to Edison**
- Submit Intent Form by April 1

Assuming you are accepted, you may then...

- Set up a meeting with Mrs. Merickel to complete registration paperwork for all HHS CCP courses and Fall Edison courses in April.
- Complete Edison orientation through their Blackboard app/website after registration

**If you do not have a 3.0 cumulative GPA and/or As and Bs in your English & Math courses, you will not qualify with your transcript. See Mrs. Merickel for help if this is you.

CCP DETAILS

- Ensure each of the CCP Admission Requirements are fulfilled. Always ask questions if you are not sure of what needs to be done next. This is a major step in the responsibility the student must take for their education.
- Be aware that scheduling conflicts may occur when working to make a course plan between two separate entities; Edison does not make their schedule around Houston and vice versa.
- Students may not exceed 30 semester hours per year between high school and CCP courses. If the student choses to enroll in more than 30 hours, the student/family is responsible for the entire cost of the course(s) exceeding the limit.
- Edison offers summer courses. These count as part of the upcoming year's 30 hrs.
- Must take into consideration athletic eligibility when scheduling
- Before a student may enroll in an online course at Edison, there is an online workshop that must be completed. This is on Blackboard, just as is the orientation.



CCP CAVEATS

- Once the student begins the CCP course they are locked into taking it for CCP credit (one week window to drop the course and/or CCP).
- Courses are for both high school and college credit. Therefore, grades earned in CCP courses will be part of HS transcript/GPA/class rank (letter grades)
- The student/family is responsible for reimbursing the school district for all costs associated with the course, if the final grade is lower than a "D." This becomes a school fee, and must be remitted in order to participate in graduation, receive a diploma, and have final transcripts released to colleges.
- If a student fails a course, there is a probationary period and process for reentering CCP. Avoid failing courses by seeking help early.



HOW TO ACCESS HELP

- Talk to your teacher/instructor early if there are any issues with a class.
