# Counselor's Corner

With another school year, there is a lot of excitement in the air about students returning back to school and new things taking place. Along with the traditional counseling services (individual, small group, and classroom guidance for academic, career, and social/emotional development to all students), we have partnered with Catholic Social Services (CSS) to provide support for our stuteaching social and teachers with teaching social and emotional curriculum. In grades K-2, we will use the Second-Step Program to teach critical skills. The skills are taught from four areas: Skills for Learning, Empathy, Emotion Management, and Problem Solving. They will learn a lot this year, and teachers will also complete daily practice activities to help your child retain skills. We will need your help. Students will bring home links that are interactive and fun activities that you and your child can complete together. This is a great way for you to see what your child is learning. Other grade levels will touch on some of the curriculum provided by Second-Step along with other life skills and social skills.

Bonnie Ihle, a licensed professional counselor from CSS, will be working with your child/children in grades K-2 one day a week. She will spend time in the K-2 classrooms and teach social and emotional skills to our students. If you would like to meet Ms. Ihle, please introduce yourself to her during open house. She will be located in the commons.

As a reminder, Ms. Ihle will only be here one day a week in the classroom with students. Due to the limited time that Ms. Bonnie Ihle will be at the school, students will see Ms. Makela for traditional counseling concerns and referrals will be made as needed.
