### 2025-2026 HH Kindergarten Screening & Registration

Hardin Houston Local School District will be conducting their Kindergarten Screening and Registration on March 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>.

Kindergarten screening is for students who will turn 5 years old on or before August 1st.
